Take exit 196A (I-520 South/Bobby Jones Expressway) take exit #3B (Gordon Highway), go 1.4 miles and turn left at the third stoplight (Highland Ave), go .5 miles and turn left at the first stoplight (Damascus Rd.) AAC is .7 miles on the right.

How to Enter

The preferred method of entering the meet is through a team management software that produces an export in .SD3 format. If you do not have a team management software package you can use the Excel Spreadsheet for entering the meets. If you enter using the Excel Spreadsheet please make sure that you enable macros. Enabling Macros will format the times correctly on Entry.

Entry Limits

Individual Events

NFHS Rules (Rule 3: Section 1) each team shall be permitted a maximum of four entries in an individual event. These four entries must meet or exceed the 2009 SCISA Swimming qualifying times.

Relay Events

- SCISA allows each team to enter two relay teams in an event as long as the relay team meets or exceeds the 2009 SCISA Swimming qualifying times for that relay event. Teams may be entered in the meet as relay only swimmers. All relay swimmers must be entered electronically with your entries. (Please remember to include relay only swimmers in your payment for the meet).
- Only one relay team may score per team.

Coaches

Coaches need to have their school's athletic director fax the SCISA office a listing of coaches by end of day on Monday September 28, 2009.

Officials and Timers

- Every school has to provide at least two (2) timers at the state meet. Please remember that to have alternate timers available.
- Please e-mail any volunteer timers and volunteer officials that are willing to work the State championships to Billy Culbertson.

Individual Events

Top 10 places shall be scored in each event.

Relay Scoring

Double the individual points. Only One Relay may score for each team in an event.

- A State Championship medal will be presented to each 1st place finisher in all events for both boys and girls in the AAA and A-AA divisions.
